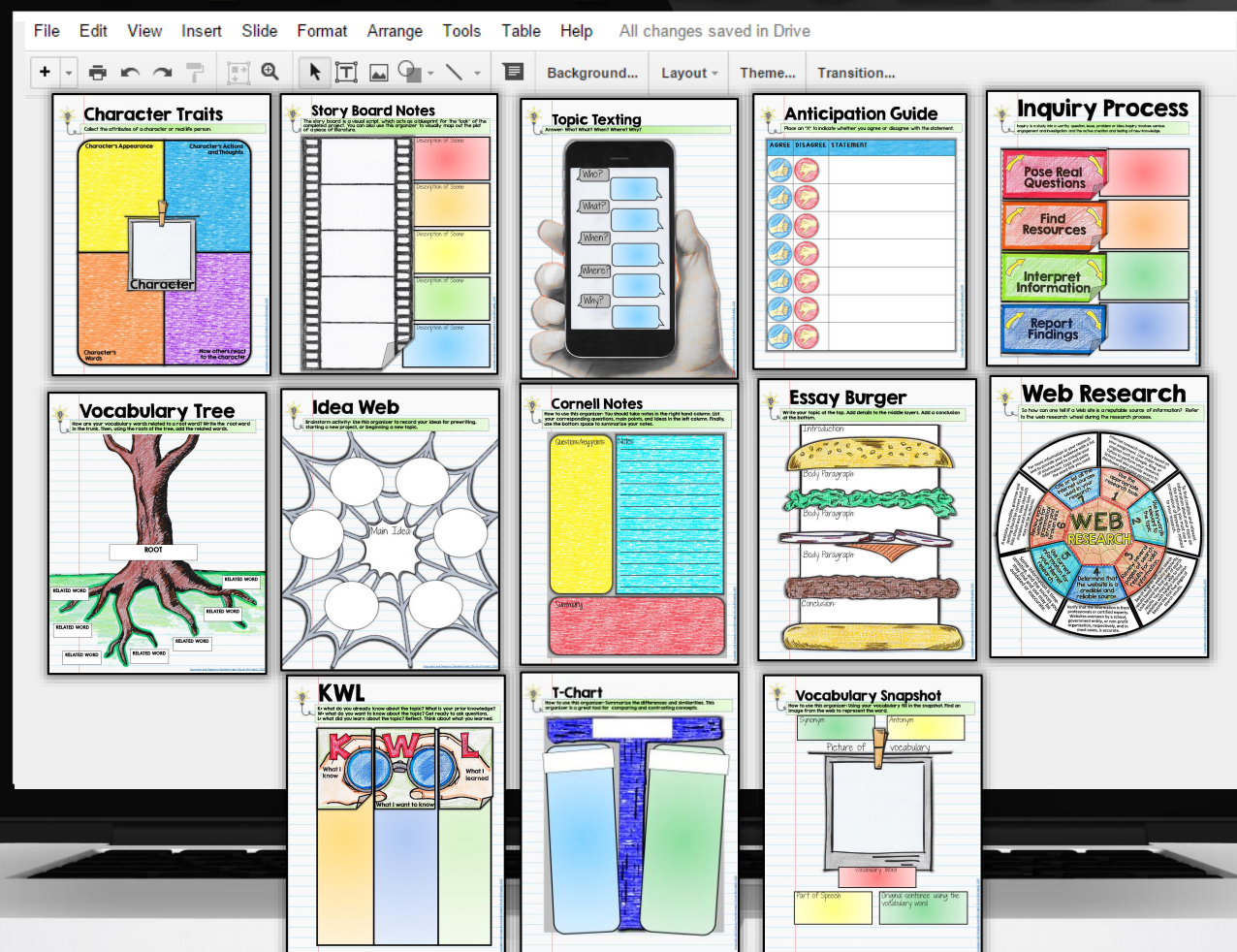

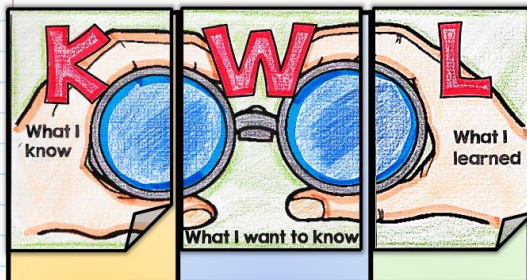
## Idea Web

## KWL

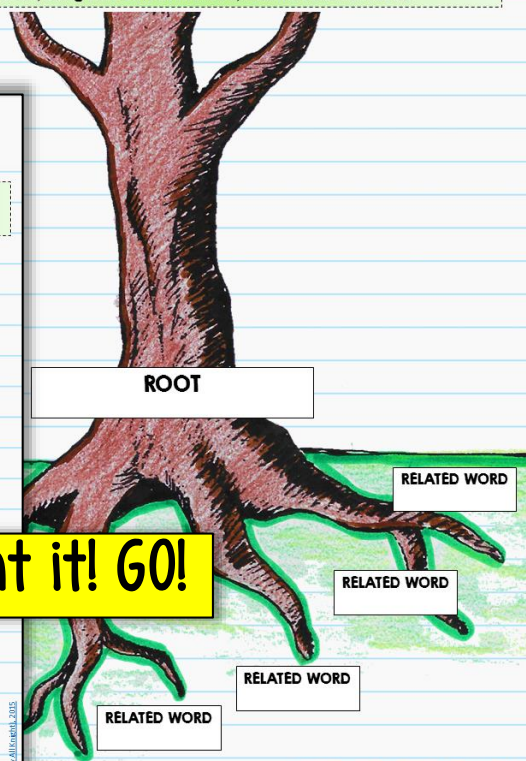
K: what do you already know about the topic? What is your prior knowledge?

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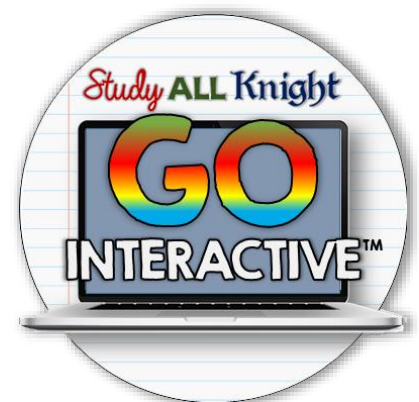
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## What you need to get started:

2. Have access to the Internet and a Google Account. (FREE)
3. Open the file on your own Google Drive and engage while in the edit mode.
4. Printer access to print out the finished product. (OPTIONAL)



## Begin your Google Slides Project:

If you haven't created a free Google account, you will need to do that before beginning the project. Each student will need their own account if they will be working on their own GO Interactive project using Google Slides.

Before you begin editing/filling in your GO Interactive notebook templates, it is **VERY** important to first save a copy of the file, on your own Google Drive, and then edit the copy. You do not want to edit the original file.
